The Surrey Bird Club (SBC) was founded in 1957 with the following objectives:

RESEARCH: to co-operate with national and local scientific ornithological enquiries and to study and record all aspects of the avifauna of Surrey.

PUBLICATION: to produce an annual report on the birds of the county to be known as the Surrey Bird Report.

CONSERVATION: to support conservation of bird life in the county.

EDUCATION: to promote an increased interest in ornithology in Surrey.

Our **Recording Area** is the historic county of Surrey, which includes that part of the county up to the River Thames at Bermondsey now in Greater London, but excludes Spelthorne.

Join us by returning a completed application form to the Membership Secretary, together with the Banker's Order and Gift Aid forms if you possibly can.

Membership Notes

- Full and Junior members, and Affiliated Societies receive free copies of Birding Surrey and the annual Surrey Bird Report.
- Renewals are due on 1st April annually.
- Subscriptions cover the period from commencement to 31st March.

- Please note that member details are kept on a database. Access to this is subject to the provisions of the Data Protection Act.
